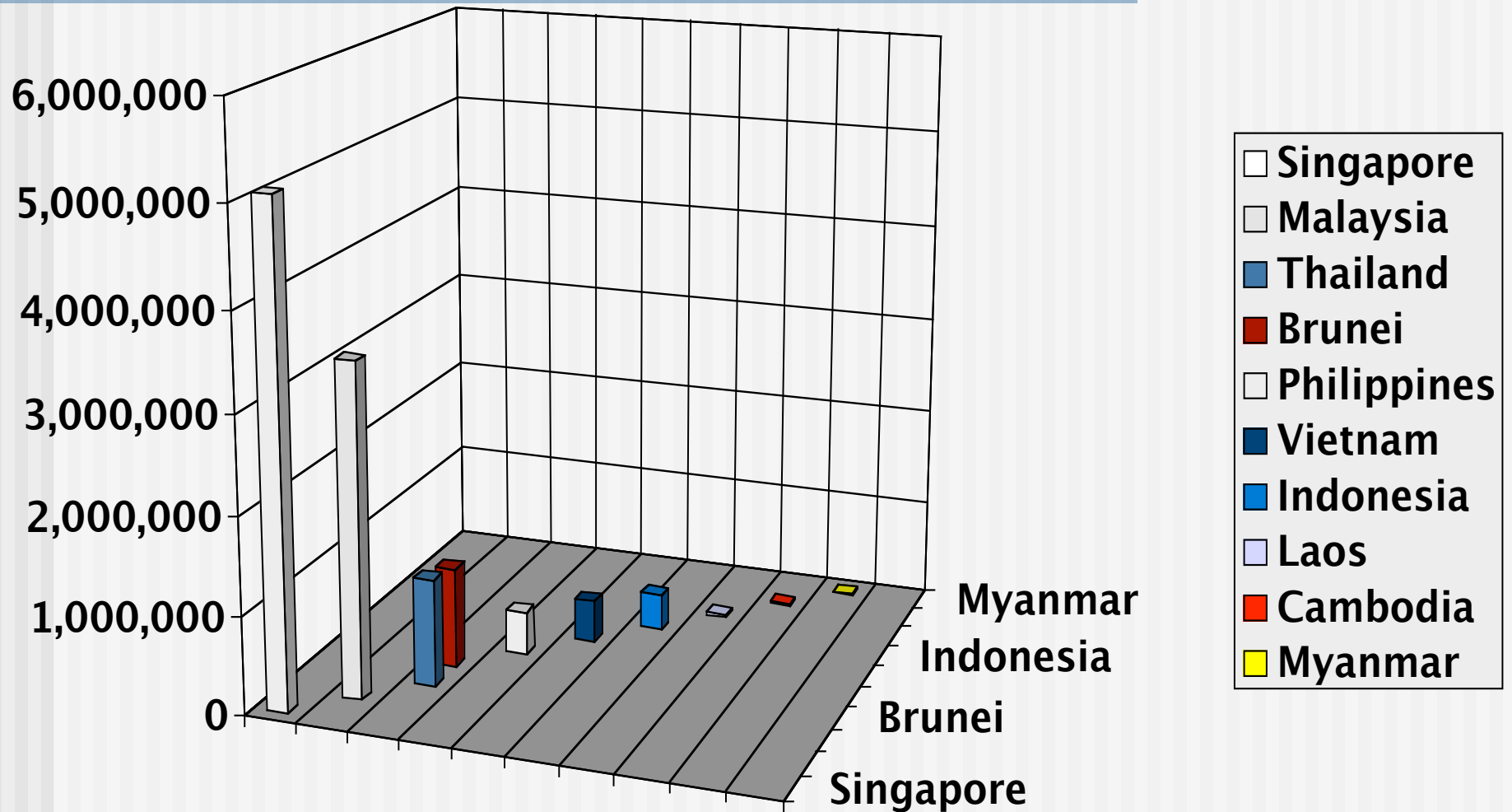

# What is the ATRC

---

- The ATRC is a grouping of Telecommunications Regulators within the ASEAN region.
- Next meeting i.e. the 11th is in Penang, Malaysia in August 2005

# Background of the ATRC Anti-Spam initiative

---

- During the last ATRC meeting in Vientiane, Laos in July 2004, member countries agreed for Malaysia (MCMC) to spearhead ATRC's action plan on Anti-Spam. The action-plan called for:
  - Exchange of skills and sharing
  - Facilitate cooperation between industry and Anti-Spam groups within ATRC economies
  - Bilateral agreements
  - Engage in cooperation with other international groups

## Cont; [Background of the ATRC Anti-Spam initiative]

---

- An Anti-Spam workshop was organized in MCMC's headquarters in Cyberjaya, Malaysia from 3rd May to 5th May 2005
- Collate information on Anti-Spam initiatives from ATRC economies
- 18 papers were presented with representations from the ITU, OECD, FTC, ACA, DCITA, MIC Japan, Microsoft, local ISPs plus regulators from ATRC i.e. MCMC, IDA, Postel, MICT, AiTi
- A closed-door meeting was held on 5th May between regulators of the ATRC.

# Anti-Spam Laws within the ATRC economies

---

- No ATRC economies have specific Anti-Spam laws

But economies do undertake:

- MOUs
- Endorsement of Action Plans

# Action Plan

---

- To be discussed in 11th ATRC meeting:
  - MOU on network security; or
  - MOU on Anti-Spam
  - Other type of cooperation



# Action Plan

---

- Upon agreement of framework - proposals:
  - Establishment of ISP Forum
    - Development of Code of Practice
    - Awareness campaign
  - Enforcement powers
    - Laws or provisions in current laws
    - Ensure enforcement powers
    - POC network for escalation
  - Information Sharing
    - Compromised servers
    - Spammers
    - Trends

# Way Forward

---

- To check disparity between ATRC economies on Anti-Spam initiatives.
- Joint programs to assist economies whose Internet penetration and network that are not matured to be better prepared.
